

## Spanish Curriculum Overview - Year 12

	Unit	Details
Autumn One	<b>Los valores tradicionales y modernos</b> <b>Dosier de cine - El laberinto del fauno</b>	In the transition to A-level pupils review key grammar from GCSE and also gain an insight into the speaking exam. Pupils learn about changes in family life, including marriage and divorce in Spain and give reasons for these changes. Pupils also embark upon their first cultural topic which is the study of the film 'El Laberinto del fauno'.
Autumn Two	<b>La Iglesia Católica</b> <b>La igualdad de los sexos - el papel de la mujer</b> <b>El ciberespacio</b>	Pupils learn about the religious history of Spain and the changing influence of the catholic church in Spain. This topic is particularly useful for post learning when pupils start to read the novel 'Requiem por un campesino español'.
Spring One	<b>La igualdad de los sexos - LGBTQI+</b> <b>La influencia de los ídolos</b>	Pupils learn about different aspects of equality in the Spanish speaking world. They consider progress that has been made and barriers to progress.
Spring Two	<b>La identidad regional en España - las tradiciones &amp; la gastronomía</b> <b>El patrimonio cultural</b>	Pupils review core language from KS4 and explore different traditions and customs in Spain and the Spanish speaking world and consider what makes Spain special. Particular attention is given to regional identity in Spain, gastronomy and the importance of regional languages.
Summer One	<b>La identidad regional en España - las lenguas.</b>  <b>Dosier de cine - El Laberinto del Fauno</b> <b>Introducción a la obra - Réquiem por un campesino español</b>	As an introduction to the novel 'Réquiem por un campesino español' pupils explore the context of the novel and the life of the author Ramón J. Sender. Pupils learn about the social and political context of 1930's Spain.
Summer Two	<b>Dosier de literatura – Réquiem por un campesino español</b> <b>Individual Research Project (IRP)</b>	Pupils read the novel 'Réquiem por un campesino español' and explore the different characters and themes.
