Autumn One	<b>Urban issues and challenges</b>		<p>The topic begins with a focus on the global patterns and process of urban change and the emergence of megacities. Pupils will then go on to investigate how urban growth in Rio de Janeiro creates opportunities and challenges. This is then contrasted when pupils look at urban change in Newcastle Upon Tyne and how this leads to a variety of social, economic and environmental opportunities and challenges. The topic concludes with a focus on features of sustainable urban living using the German city of Freiburg as a case study.</p>

Spring One	<b>The changing economic world</b>		<p>There are global variations in economic development and quality of life. Various strategies exist for reducing the global development gap. Some LICs and NEEs are experiencing rapid economic development which leads to significant social, environmental and cultural change. Major changes in the economy of the UK have affected, and will continue to affect, employment patterns and regional growth</p>
